
#### **Noisy Cargos**

#### Noisy Ships


- Two vessels giving rise to most concern Joglea, Nadi

# Air Quality – SO<sub>2</sub>




Recent assessment of air quality and impacts of lockdown – tentative indication MARPOL had reduced SO<sub>2</sub>

#### SO2 Rata Street





Evidence of SO<sub>2</sub> improvement from Port Tauranga
